ACCEPTABLE IDENTIFICATION FOR STATUS CARD ISSUANCE

Clients must provide the following I.D. from **one** of the following Categories when applying for a **Certificate of Indian Status (CIS)** :

One piece of Primary I.D. OR Two pieces of Secondary I.D.
one w/digitized photo

- * I.D. must be intact and readable
- * Your previously issued Status Card (even if expired) must be returned to the issuing officer upon receipt of your replacement/renewal Status Card
