Announcing two awards for Aboriginal women for the Bachelor of Commerce Program at the Sauder School of Business at UBC

- 1. The Spitz Family Entrance Award for Aboriginal Women
- 2. The Spitz Family Transfer Award for Aboriginal Women

Available for Aboriginal women entering and transferring to the Bachelor of Commerce program with preference to applicants from remote communities in BC. Award renews annually until degree completion, pending academic standing.

Each award starts at \$10,000 with additional comprehensive funding available for housing, food, childcare, travel and academic support based on financial need.
